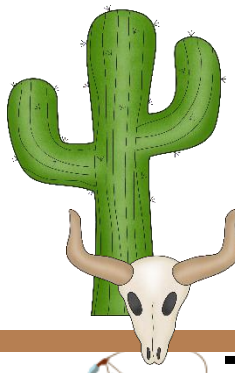

Math

- We have the First Quarter PMA on Monday that will cover all the standards that were covered since the beginning of the year.
- We will begin learning the four division strategies required of our division standard. Please note that the standards algorithm of division (long division) is a Sixth Grade standard and will not be covered.
- i-Ready Math is assigned as homework each week. Students need to complete **45 minutes at home** each week. A week runs from Monday to Sunday. Two grades are taken from this: one for time on task (out of 45 mins) and another for the average of the quizzes taken.
