### Math

We have started the work in the fractions unit! We begin with using Rectangular Fraction Models to show how to find common denominators. This is part of the 5.NF.1.2 standard: "Solve word problems involving addition and subtraction of fractions referring to the same whole, including cases of unlike denominators, e.g., by using visual fraction models..."

- i-Ready Math is assigned as homework each week. Students need to complete 45 minutes at home each week. A week runs from Monday to Sunday. Two grades are taken from this: one for time on task (out of 45 mins) and another for the average of the quizzes taken.
